Gloucester City Homes Tenant Board member elections - Results

Gloucester City Homes has announced the results of its second elections for one of the tenant places on its Board of Directors, with Matson tenant, Gina Hobbs being appointed to the Board.

The announcement was made at Gloucester City Homes' Annual General Meeting on 30th July.

The Board, which is responsible for setting the company's business strategy, policies and overseeing the running of the company, is made up of 5 tenants (including a leaseholder representative); 5 councillors (nominated by Gloucester City Council) and 5 independent members, who bring a wide range of skills and experience to the organisation.

Five tenants stood in the election, and over 700 tenants and leaseholders cast their votes, a turnout of nearly 14%.

Customers were able to vote by post, or if they preferred, by text, telephone or on-line.

Chair of the Board Tim Dare stated:

'We are delighted to welcome Gina to the Board. The election demonstrates democracy in action at Board level and tenant involvement in decision making at strategic level. I would like to thank each of the candidates who took part and everyone who voted.'
